

# INTRODUCTION


ECO BOOKWORM:

A few galactic meters away there is another house. Lady Venus lives in this house. She is a TV reporter and she always knows what is happening in the city.





That afternoon, while slowly sipping her tea, Betty learned why Pluto became homeless. He wasn't always a tramp....




## CHAPTER FOUR
